### MINUTES

A quorum was declared present

The Investment Committee gave a presentation on investment options for funds acquired through the sale of the KC Council 4902 house in October of 2015. Over the past year, the Investment Committee has interviewed professionals from five different investment companies, gathering facts and data in regard to investment opportunities. The committee set up strict guidelines including the following:

- Investments must match the core values of the Knights of Columbus
- Protect the principle while still providing a return better than a certificate of deposit
- Funds must be readily accessible
- Working with a local agent available for questions.

After months of critical thinking, the Investment Committee has proposed a recommendation:

*To deposit the entire balance of the KC Council 4902 House Sale Money Market account, approximately \$84,000, into the Edward D Jones Money Market account and follow the recommendation of Vince Seidling in developing an incremental investment program.*

This proposal, from the Investment Committee, will be presented at the April meeting and voted on. Brother Knights are encouraged to attend the April 10 meeting and vote on the recommended proposal.

Jim Bot made a motion to pay the bills. Approved.

Ron DeCoux made a motion to pay the \$250 refundable security deposit for Bacon Bash. Approved.
