MINUTES

Before our meeting we watched a video from the "Into the Breach" series. Thanks, Paul for coordinating this.

Scott Conway was the \$150 raffle prize for March.

The council meeting was called to order at 7:04 on March 14th by Grand Knight Bob Casey.

It was determined that a quorum was present.

The meeting minutes be approved as edited/corrected.

Treasurer's report showed \$22,931.05 in the General Fund and \$2,016.47 in the Emergency Fund.

Financial Secretary's report requested approval of \$948.12 in expenses and \$1,291.80 in income. A motion to pay the bills was approved.

We discussed the KC 150 Raffle. We began selling tickets at the March meeting and will continue to after each mass until they are sold. The tickets will also be sold at each

meeting so if you have not purchased one yet, please support the council and purchase one. The church office also have a supply. As of April 3rd, we have only sold about 40 tickets, so we have a long way to go. A sign-up Genius link is attached to this email.

The scholarship committee narrowed the candidates and choose 2 students to be awarded \$1,000 each at the scholarship ceremony on May 10th. We will release the names at that time. Thanks Doug, Alan, Scott, and Bill for your work on this.

Doug reported on the "Dad's" project and said the small group will be meeting in the near term to discuss the program, location and speaker(s).

All of us are aware of the atrocities of the war in Ukraine and the human loss and suffering. At this time Supreme will match donations up to \$500,000. A motion was made and seconded to contribute \$5,000 to the Ukrainian people and the relief efforts. Since this expense is outside of our budget and exceeds \$1,000 a vote on this motion will be held at our April meeting.
