The Treasurer's report showed \$32,648.05 in the General Fund and \$1,216.70 in the Emergency Fund.

The Financial Secretary's report requested approval of \$11,239.32 in expenses and \$6,937.05 in income. A motion to pay the bills was approved.

Chaplins Report Father Jerry Harris mentioned to keep praying for all the sick people listed in the bulletin and for our country with everything going on. The 2022 KC 150 Raffle is now done. The 2023 KC 150 Raffle will start with the first drawing on July 11th before the business meeting. We have sold a total of 107 so we sold 7 more than last year (the council and parish members once again really stepped up) Thanks to Tim Iehl for all of your time and extra efforts on this event. The money we raise from this continues to help support our many programs.
