Before the meeting Shelly Smith, Director of Our Neighbor's Place presented on all the programs the organization has for those in our community that need help with housing, clothing and food. We are blessed to have this organization in our community to help those less fortunate.

The council meeting was called to order at 7:31 on February 14th by Grand Knight Bob Casey.

It was determined that a quorum was present.

The meeting minutes be approved as edited/corrected.

Treasure's report showed \$24,263.47 in the General Fund and \$2,016.47 in the Emergency Fund.

Financial Secretary's report requested approval of \$3,193.55 in expenses and \$1,728.74 in income. A motion to pay the bills was approved.

The 2022 Budget was approved.

We discussed the KC 150 Raffle. This year we will sell 150 tickets with an estimated profit of \$11,950. We will open the sales up to the parish right away this year by selling after the masses and making them available in the office.

Once again it is time to screen candidates for the (2) \$1,000 KC Scholarships. Doug Wiess stated he has a committee ready and will share the applications with them once they have been submitted. Thanks, guys, for serving on this committee.

At the Officer's Meeting and again at the Business meeting we discussed an event or speaker that would be centered on developing fathers in our community. Father McGivney founded the Knights of Columbus recognizing that fathers are essential to the family and he wanted to take care of families when the breadwinner passed away. Strong families lead to strong communities. For the time this will be called the "Dad's Project" We discussed hosting an event(s) at St Bridget's but opening it up to the entire community of fathers in hopes it will be widely attended. We also discussed ways to encourage fathers that wouldn't normally attend this type of event but would benefit from it.
