The council meeting was called to order at 7:03 on April 11<sup>th</sup> by Deputy Grand Knight Tim Wilson. Thanks for standing in for me!

It was determined that a quorum was present.

The March meeting minutes were approved as submitted.

Treasure's report showed \$23,319.56 in the General Fund and \$2,016.47 in the Emergency Fund.

Financial Secretary's report requested approval of \$8,544.57 in expenses and \$5,560.60 in income. A motion to pay the bills was approved.

District Deputy Joe Raehsler reminder the council of upcoming dates including the state convention on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup>. The District 81 Columbus Banquet will be October 9<sup>th</sup> at Tattersall Event Center in River Falls. Meet and greet at noon, meal at 12:30 followed by a speaker at 2:30. Tim Iehl reported 52 tickets have been sold (as of this writing there are 71 sold-we still have 79 to sell) Most of the sales were to those that purchased last year but there were 19 new buyers.
