MINUTES

The council meeting was called to order at 7:01 on October 11th by Grand Knight Bob Casey.

It was determined that a quorum was present.

Richard Jorgenson moved the meeting minutes be approved as amended.

Treasure's report showed \$39,499.44 in the General Fund and \$881.22 in the Emergency Fund. A matured certificate of deposit for approximately \$7,000 was transferred into the General Fund. Scott Lindall made a motion to transfer \$14,623.69 to from our checking account into our Edward D Jones account. This motion will be voted on at our November meeting. suggested that we transfer it into our Edward D Jones mutual funds. If you should have any questions about this please contact Scott, Doug or myself. Discussion will also be held before the vote.

Financial Secretary's report requested approval of \$6,392.73 in expenses and \$3,052.54 in income.

The Tootsie Roll Drive netted \$2,252.54. I will send grant information to Have a Heart, Walk on Stables and the River Falls School District. Grant applications are due 11/15/2021 and disbursed in the spring. Regardless of these organizations win a grant they will receive an allocation from our gross sales.

Doug Weiss reported on the membership drive held the weekend of October 10th. We handed out hundreds of prayer cards and many "Why Join" brochures to prospective members. Darwin Smith from Preston Minnesota will be transferring into our council. We discussed that a membership drive can't be just one day or weekend. We need to be looking for new, active members all of the time. The personal invitation is always the most effective.

Dave Andrea said the KC social held at Rush River was successful in that members got a chance to socialize but unfortunately no potential members attended.

We discussed future social events. BJ Grant and Gene Cernohous have chaired the Christmas Social for several years but have decided to be helpers instead of chairs. Anyone interested in chairing this event please let one of the officers know.

Richard Jorgensen has suggested we, as a council, go out for lunch or dinner once a month wearing our shirts to promote the council and of course get a chance to socialize.
